### **SCHOOL ATTORNEY**

The School Attorney may be appointed by the Board for a period of one (1) year. Such appointment shall be made at the reorganizational meeting.

The School Attorney shall be responsible for rendering legal advice, counsel and opinions on legal matters before the Board, including but not limited to:

1. Providing counsel to the Board of any legal questions as requested.
2. Representing the School District in litigation and in all other matters that the Board may deem proper and advisable.
3. Conducting hearings as requested.
