SPECIAL LEGAL COUNSEL FOR EDUCATION MATTERS

The special legal counsel for education matters shall be appointed by the Board for a period of one (1) year. Such appointment shall be made at the reorganizational meeting.

The special legal counsel for education matters shall assist the Board of Education in the rendering of legal advice, counsel, representation, and such other matters as required by the Superintendent, Board or school attorney in matters where special expertise in educational law is necessary or advisable, or in matters where conflict of interest or other reasons prevent the school attorney's involvement, including:

1. Providing counsel to the Board on matters of and relating to education law.
2. Representing the School District in designated litigation relating to education law.
