POWER AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD

Board of Education members as individuals or committees have no power. The Board of Education acting in its legal capacity shall transact its business in the same manner as any corporation. Its acts are required to be carried out by motions duly enacted and passed by the Board at a legal meeting.

A vote of three (3) in the affirmative shall be required for the passage of all motions, except as otherwise provided by law.

Each Board member will become familiar with the powers and duties of the Board as enumerated in Section 1709 of the New York State Education Law.

The Superintendent of Schools will provide copies of such powers and duties for the various School Board Members.
