

## **Town of Webb UFSD Response to Intervention**

"Response to Intervention (RTI) ...involves identifying children who are not meeting grade-level expectations and who are presumably at risk for continuing to lag behind their peers early on and providing instructional modifications (interventions) for these children that are instituted early in their educational careers. The students' progress is closely monitored to determine whether and when additional modifications need to be made or whether the interventions can be discontinued because the student is performing at or close to grade level. The goal of the instructional modifications is to accelerate the children's rate of growth so that they will be able to meet grade-level expectations. In an RTI model, when appropriately intensified and targeted interventions fail to lead to accelerated progress in learning, the child would be referred to the Committee on Special Education."

All students grades K-6 will be involved in the universal screening process three (3) times per academic year.
