

SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

The Board recognizes the need to develop a volunteer program to support District instructional programs and extracurricular activities. The purpose of the volunteer program will be to:

1. Support the Town of Webb UFSD staff as they carry out the educational process.
2. Build an understanding of school programs among interested citizens, thus stimulating widespread involvement in the educational process and strengthening school-community relations through positive participation.

A volunteer is an adult who works on a regular or occasional basis at school sites or other educational facilities to support the efforts of coaches and professional personnel. Such volunteer worker will serve in that capacity without compensation or employee benefits of any type, except for liability protection as provided by State law.

Use of volunteers within the District is not to conflict with or replace any regular position.

Volunteers will work with students under the immediate supervision and direction of a certified teacher, administrator or coach.

Volunteers are expected to comply with all rules and regulations set forth by the District.

All volunteers must be Board appointed prior to volunteering.
