ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The alternative school program is intended for students who are not able to function in the structure of a regular school setting or who are potential dropouts.

A decision to place a student in the BOCES alternative school program will be based on a review of all student records and a meeting of the student and parent or guardian with appropriate school representatives to review the records fully and to discuss the matter.

The District will require students in the alternative education program to meet State graduation requirements. The District will maintain evidence of student accomplishments and progress in the program.

The District may transfer students back into the regular school program when such a transfer is educationally sound.
