STRUCTURAL SAFETY INSPECTIONS

It shall be the duty of the Board of Education to ensure that each facility owned by the District which is used for instructional purposes shall be inspected annually for structural deficiencies. Every annual structural safety inspection shall be a visual inspection which will examine the structural elements of each building, and may also include inspection of building systems such as heating, plumbing and electrical systems as they relate to the structural integrity of the building in question.

If a visual inspection results in a determination that a building may have a structural deficiency, then the building shall be inspected by a licensed architect or a licensed professional engineer. The annual structural safety inspection shall be made and submitted to the State Education Department by the required timeline.
