

**STUDENT ATTENDANCE:  
AGES FOR ADMISSION AND CONTINUING ATTENDANCE**

1. KINDERGARTEN

As a general practice, the Town of Webb Union Free School District expects that:

- 1.1 All children who are or will be five years old before December 1 shall be admitted to Kindergarten.
- 1.2 A birth certificate, or other legally acceptable proof of age, shall be required of all students seeking enrollment in Kindergarten.
- 1.3 All children will spend one year in Kindergarten before going on to the first grade, unless demonstrated ready for educational advancement by the Principal.

2. FIRST GRADE

Children who have successfully completed Kindergarten, and who are or will be at least six years old on or before December 1 will be admitted to the first grade.

3. TRANSFERS

Students transferring into the Town of Webb Union Free School District shall be placed in the appropriate grade after their transcripts have been examined, and after they have been screened in accordance with Board Policy #500.6.

4. STUDENTS OVER THE COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGE

- 4.1 Students over the compulsory age, but not yet 21 years old, remain eligible for tuition-free attendance until they earn their high school diploma.
- 4.2 Students shall be encouraged to remain in school until they graduate.
- 4.3 Students in this age group are subject to the laws and rules which require regular attendance. If a student over the compulsory age does not attend regularly, the district will initiate the procedures for dropping his/her name from the rolls in accordance with Board Policy #501.2.
- 4.4 A student who graduates from high school, or who reaches age 21 without graduating, ceases to be eligible for tuition-free attendance.
  - 4.40 Students who reach age 21 during a school year may continue to attend school tuition-free until the end of that school year.
  - 4.41 Students who wish to enroll fulltime after their 21st birthdays must pay tuition for the full year.

4.42 Students who have a disability may be eligible for adult services through various governmental agencies. The District provides such information to the families of such students before their 21st birthdays.

4.5 Students whose parent/guardians move out of the School District during their senior year, may complete their senior year at no cost if they reside in the District or reside in another District but provide their own transportation.

5. POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

5.1 Veterans of the United States Armed Forces, who have graduated from high school but are not yet 21 years old, and who are residents of the district, may return to school without paying tuition.

5.2 All other postgraduates under age 21 may return to school upon payment of tuition.

5.3 All postgraduates shall be admitted to courses where space is available after all current high school students have enrolled in their courses.

5.4 Postgraduate students under age 21 may use regularly scheduled bus routes provided that seating is available. No other transportation will be provided.

5.5 The District reserves the authority to provide adult education courses for students over the age of 21 if there is sufficient demand, which is not met by other offerings in the area.
