TUTORING

No teacher shall tutor for pay any student enrolled in his/her class at the time of tutoring, except for approved home instruction.

A student unable to attend school and who wishes tutoring in order to receive school credit must have the tutor and subject matter approved by the Superintendent or his designee before the tutoring begins.

Normally a student must be absent for 10 days before tutoring begins. If the student will be absent for more than 10 days, the student may receive tutoring immediately if a Dr's note is presented.
