EXTRA-CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES - REGULATIONS

An extra-classroom activity may be defined as any school-sponsored activity for which no academic credit is given.

All extra-curricular activities, groups, and clubs shall be approved by the Board of Education. The Building Principal shall maintain an up-to-date register of activities that have been approved.

Student organizations are assigned faculty advisors appointed by the Board of Education. Advisors shall attend all meetings of their respective activity, such to be held at least once monthly during the school year. Activities shall not meet away from school property, unless they have received prior consent from the Superintendent.

Each activity shall have officers elected annually from among the membership. Each activity shall adopt by-laws prescribing the purposes of the organization, duties of the officer, membership requirements, rules of procedure, and other matters deemed necessary. These by-laws shall be approved by the Board of Education.

All posters relating to extra-curricular activities shall require the approval of the Principal prior to posting.

All activity funds shall be governed by Board Policy #708.

Participation by students in extra-curricular activities is a privilege, carrying with it the responsibility of good behavior in and out of school. Failure on the part of any student to meet this responsibility renders him/her liable to the suspension of his/her privilege of participating in extra-curricular activities or of holding class or organizational offices. Decisions relative to the eligibility or ineligibility of students are delegated to the Principal and to those individuals or groups they may directly or indirectly designate.
