Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Student Agreement for Grades 6-12

Purpose:

In an effort to put students at the center and empower them to take control of their learning, The Town of Webb UFSD will allow students in grades 6-12 to use personal technology devices once registered although the school will issue them a device for their use as part of the grade 6-12 1:1 initiative. Students wishing to participate must follow the responsibilities stated in the Acceptable Use Policy as well as the stated rules below.

Device Types:

For the purpose of this program, the word "device" means a privately owned wireless and/or portable piece of electronic equipment that includes laptops, netbooks, tablets/slates, e-readers and other wifi only devices (ie iPad and Galaxy Note). Devices with access to data plans outside of the District's network are not permitted. This restriction is inclusive of any and all cell phones. Please follow the Code of Conduct for specifics regarding cell phones.

Rules:

- 1. Any student who wishes to use a personally owned electronic device in the building or on the grounds of the Town of Webb UFSD must read and sign this agreement and submit it to the main office for review and to begin the process of device allowance on the network.
- 2. The student takes full responsibility for his or her device keeping it with himself or herself at all times. The district in NOT responsible for the security, care, repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device.
- 3. The school reserves the right to inspect a personal device. Any violations of Board policy, administrative procedures, school rules or any misconduct while using the personal device may result in the loss of the privilege allowing use of the device at school. Further disciplinary action is possible.
- 4. Personal devices shall be charged prior to bringing the device to school. The device shall be capable of running off of its own battery while at school. The student should have no expectation that they will be allowed to charge the device on campus.
- 5. The student may not use the device to record, transmit or post photos or a video of any person or persons on campus.
- 6. Wired network access as well as mobile broadband access (through external data plan) is NOT permitted. All devices must connect via the school network to be considered part of BYOD.
- 7. Students may only use their own devices by permission of the staff member who is responsible for the student at that time and only after the device has been properly registered and approved for use by the District.

As a student I understand and will abide by the Reasonable Use Agreement and the BYOD agreement. I further understand that any violation of the above may result in the loss of my network and/or device privileges as well as other disciplinary action.

As a parent I understand that my child will be responsible for abiding by the Responsible Use Agreement and the BYOD agreement. I have read and discussed them with her/him and they understand the responsibility they have in the use of the TOWUFSD network and their personal device.
